



General Education courses will be reduced to 30 minutes per week for 10 weeks . Each professor will teach 3 sections of 80 students all at the same time on Fridays from 5:30-6 pm. One class will be held in J-wing, one in H-wing, and the other on the 3rd floor of E-wing.

Professors will travel from class to class allowing for 6.5 minutes of contact time with each group. Travel time will not be included on SWFs, but caffeine infusions will be covered by Extended Health Care benefits.
