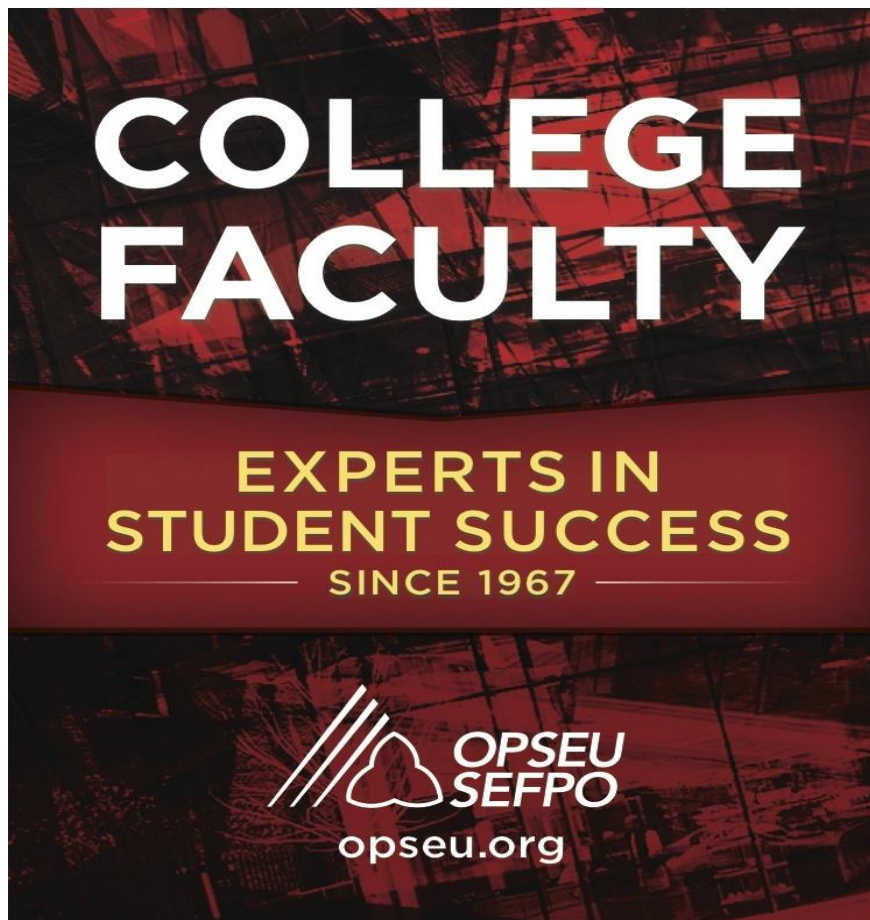


Update from Bargaining Team
